



COFFEE MAKERS

OPERATION

1. Fill coffee pot with COLD water to desired amount.
2. Insert stem into pot, making sure that it is properly seated. Place basket on stem.
3. Add coffee to basket (see equivalents below).
4. Plug coffee pot into standard 110 volt electrical outlet. Since coffee makers require as much as 1500 watts to operate properly, each coffee maker should be on a separate dedicated electrical circuit. Avoid using excessively long extension cords.
5. When coffee has finished brewing, the pot will keep the coffee hot.

BREWING TIME

It takes approximately ½ hour to brew coffee in a 36 cup coffee maker, 1 hour in a 55 cup coffee maker, and 1 ½ hours in a 100 cup coffee maker.

CLEANING

Rinse out coffee pot and basket before returning.

NOTE: NEVER immerse coffee pot in water.

COFFEE EQUIVALENTS

Number of cups	Coffee measure*
36	2 cups
55	3 ½ cups
100	6 cups

*You may want to adjust the amounts slightly according to your taste.

One pound of coffee is equal to approximately 4 ¾ cups of ground coffee.



CAUTION



DO NOT immerse coffee maker in water.
DO NOT use scouring pads or cleaning abrasives on the coffee maker.
DO NOT take coffee maker apart.
